



IKART Championship / 2014 ROK Cup, Races on July 5th and 6th

Important Information

In order to promote karting competition, the 4th race of the I-KART Championship / 2014 ROK CUP is taking place at the same time as the ICAR Grand Prix / NASCAR Canadian Tire Series.

You must have a general admission ticket to enter the site.

Practice sessions are on Friday; there is a race on Saturday and an additional "Bonus" race on Sunday morning.

On Sunday afternoon, the MINI ROK and Shifter drivers are invited to complete a demonstration run in front of the NASCAR fans on the main track!

The NASCAR Canadian Tire series race is Sunday afternoon.

Registration:

Specific Race Rules

The specific rules take precedence over other rules. The information provided at the drivers meeting will be considered part of the specific rules.

Technical Inspection

- A technical inspection form will be provided at registration, and the participants must complete it and submit it to the technical inspector, in order to receive the participation sticker
- For the I-Kart Championship, the Rotax motors must conform to the current regulations of the Quebec Cup; for the ROK CUP, the ROK regulations for ROK Cup USA are applicable
- The weights are as per the chart
- When using new tires, they must be installed for the practices
- Only Vega and Mojo tires are permitted, as per the chart
- The race organiser reserves the right to modify the rules without prior notice

Race Procedures

- All classes will be rolling starts, except for the 6-speed class (with a minimum of six participants)
- Pole position is the inside of corner one, and cannot be changed
- Following a red flag, the restart will be in single file in the order of the last turn before the incident
- The driver causing a stopped session will restart from last place
- During a stopped session due to an accident, no work on the karts is authorised
